WHAT | Miami's CAP Assessment

- CAP: Circularity Assessment Protocol We are actively working with the City of Miami
 and the University of Georgia to understand how our city's waste management, social
 behaviors and marketplace trends create waste and pollution.
- **GOAL**: Reduce plastic waste, trash and debris from collecting in our waterways and littering our streets and parks.
- WHY: When this waste enters the waterways of our magic city, it pollutes our rivers, bay and the ocean, posing a threat to our health, economy, environment and wildlife.
- **SO FAR:** Research teams have collected on-the-ground data and assessed management of plastics at the community level.
- **NEXT:** The final report is close to being released! It provides science-backed data and recommendations to inform city-level decision-making which can clean up pollution in our communities and waters, but we need your help to make that happen!

HOW | Join your neighborhood's working group

- We need your input to determine the actions for your community, because we know those who call your neighborhood home know it best!
- Residents like you can join the working group to review the report from our research teams and develop the action plan for your community together.
 - 2 4 applicants will be selected to join the working group
 - Working groups will meet every other week, starting in late January
 - · Meetings will take place virtually or in-person as decided by the group
 - · All working groups will be led by a facilitator
 - Interpreters will be provided for spanish and creole speaking members
